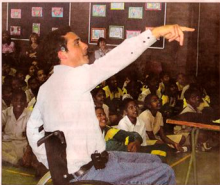


Motivational Speaker Inspires Learners

Cy Edmondson made history as the first paralympic to attend Southern Peak in the Philippines in 2007. Now a motivational speaker, Edmondson appeared as a guest speaker at Philippine Science High School on Monday, 20 August, and left learners with some healthy food for thought. Edmondson's visit was the country's largest awareness of people

living with disabilities. At the age of 16, Cy Edmondson contracted a cerebral disease, leaving him in a coma for 12 months. When he awoke, he was paralysed and faced a future in a wheelchair. However, Edmondson has chosen to approach his disability with a positive attitude, not believing for a second that it stopped his dreams or ability to look up life as an example for others living apart from disability.
